

Miss Vergas Contestant Agreement

I _____ fully understand that if I receive the title of Miss Vergas 2009, I will be obligated to fulfill the duties of this title.

1. I will act in the capacity of ambassador for the community of Vergas for one full year; starting the night I receive my title until my successor is crowned the following year.
2. I will make every reasonable attempt to attend all appearances scheduled for me.
3. I will dress in appropriate attire, as deemed necessary by the scholarship pageant committee.
4. I will conduct myself in a manner that will command respect from the public.
5. All my actions will reflect high moral character.
6. I am not nor ever have co-habitated with a member of the opposite sex.
7. I have never been married, divorced, nor had a marriage annulled.
8. I have never been pregnant.
9. I have never been arrested and convicted of breaking the law as an adult.

I fully understand that if I default on any of the above listed rules I will be obligated to immediately relinquish my crown.

I fully understand the Miss Vergas Scholarship Committee will have the ultimate authority in the decision making process of determining the behavior and actions of "Miss Vergas." The decision of the committee is final.

I fully understand that I will forfeit the educational scholarship of \$700 if my title is terminated. It will be my responsibility to reimburse the Miss Vergas Scholarship Program Committee for all expenses that were paid on my behalf; limited to: professional photographs, attire, and personal travel. The tiara and banner will be returned immediately to the Miss Vergas Program Committee.

I fully understand that all scholarships will be paid according to the following schedule.

Miss Vergas 2009 \$700

*If Miss Vergas is attending high school during her reign she will received her educational scholarship when she produces a transcript from the first semester of her post secondary schooling, after graduation from high school. A student attending college as a PSEO student will not receive the scholarship until the she has completed one semester of post secondary schooling and is in good academic standing after she receives her high school diploma.

* If Miss Vergas is attending college during her reign she will be awarded her scholarship the evening she crowns her successor the following year. She must produce proof of attendance to a post secondary college or vocational training program with a transcript for at least one semester and is in good academic standing from the year of her reign.

* If Miss Vergas graduates from high school, but chooses not to attend post secondary education the year after she graduates, she will have a limit of three (3) years from the date she crowns her successor to attend post secondary schooling or she will forfeit the Miss Vergas Scholarship of \$700.00. She must produce an official transcript and be in good academic standing to verify her attendance for a minimum of one semester of post secondary education to claim her scholarship within the three year limit.
