To Apply:

1. Write a maximum 300, word essay detailing your community experiences.
2. All essays must be word-processed. 12 point, double spaced.
3. Please do not submit pictures. Scrapbooks or any other materials other than your essay.
4. Make a cover sheet for your essay with the following information on it: Title, Name, Address, & Date
5. Please sign and date the bottom of your essay in ink.
6. You may not apply if you have already won this award.
7. Submit your essay by Friday, July 31st, 2009 by 7pm
